Type of Placement: Afternoon group visit to the County Courts to gain in insight into the work of the court and the jury process

Curriculum Link: Citizenship, PSHE, Health and Social Care Courses, Society, Health and Development Diploma (which includes Justice)

Summary of Main Benefits:

- Opportunity to see behind the scenes at court
- Chance to meet key personnel
- Chance to gain case study material

Description:

The placement included an overview of the County Court, a tour of the premises and discussions with key personnel, including a judge and a bailiff. The delegates were also shown a video of the role of a juror and had a Q and A session.

Outcomes:

- Delegates gained a better understanding of the court process
- Opportunities for further work-related learning and case studies were identified
- Opportunities for speakers and further visits were explored
